- "L438" is a code for the author's last name "Learner"

QUESTION 3

Referring again to Luci Learner's book:

Which part(s) of that record should you write down BEFORE you search for the book on the shelf (choose 1)

- author's name (Luci Learner)
- just the call number (374.0132 L438)
- call number plus first few words of the title (374.0132 L438 + How to win lecturers)
